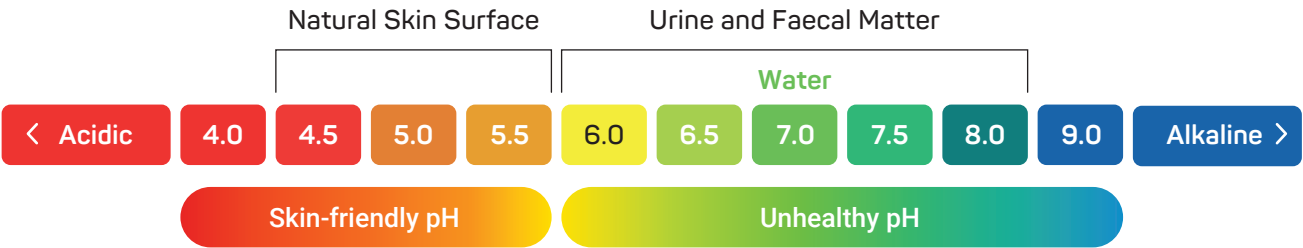

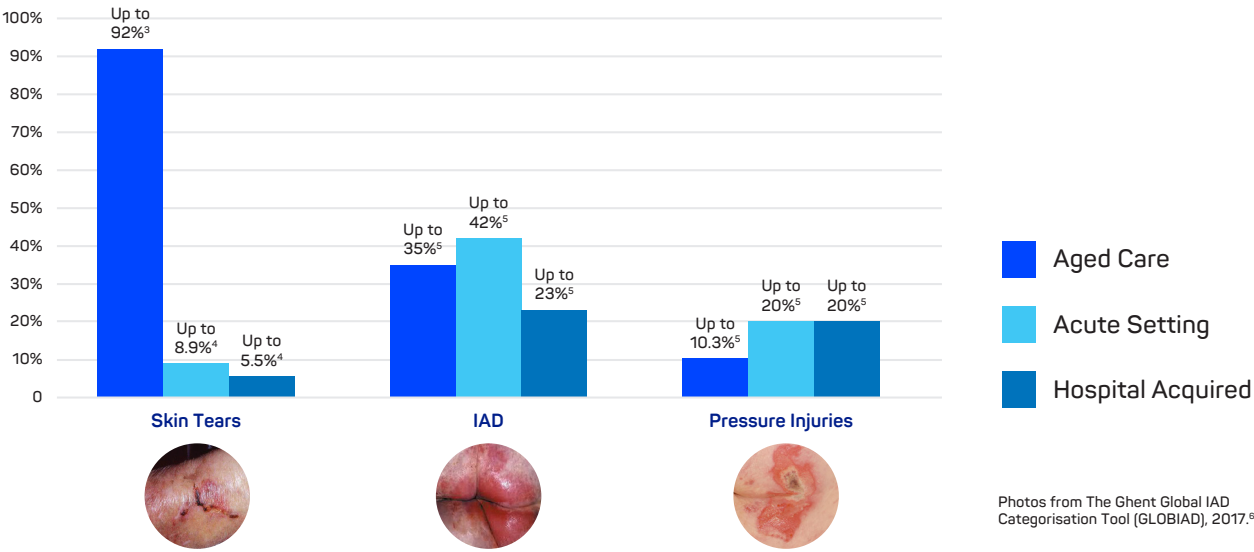
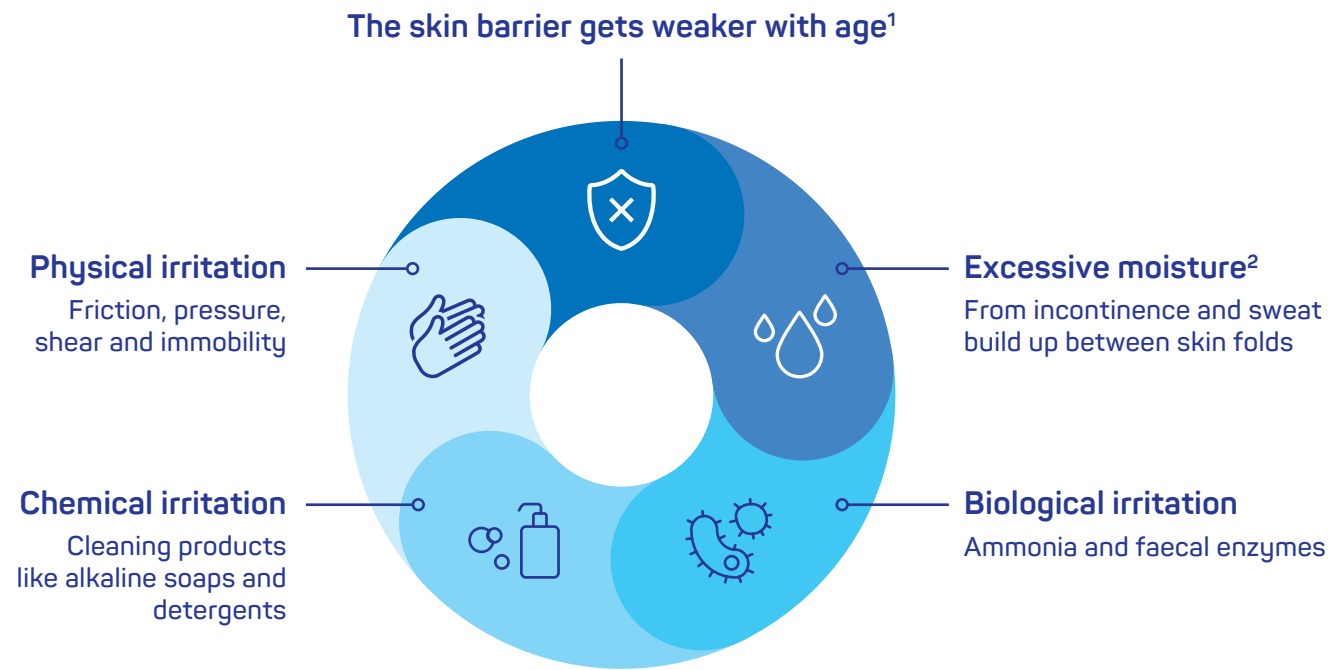
Importance of healthy skin

The skin is the largest organ in the human body and plays a vital role in protecting it from external factors. The skin's surface is covered by a delicate acidic film known as the acid protection mantle, that shields against harmful environmental factors and bacteria. Maintaining a slightly acidic pH of 4.5 to 5.5 is essential for skin integrity.

Multiple risk factors, can weaken the skin and make it more susceptible to damage. This can lead to a range of skin conditions, including skin tears, Incontinence Associated Dermatitis (IAD), and pressure injuries (PI). It is essential to maintain skin integrity to prevent these conditions.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use soapless, no-rinse and/or pH-neutral skin cleansers.¹⁴ Moisturise the skin twice daily to reduce incidence up to 50%.¹⁵ 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use a cleanser with a low surfactant.¹⁰ Soap and water should be avoided to maintain the skin's normal pH.¹¹ Use cleansers, wipes or emollients that will cleanse and moisturise at the same time, reducing skin irritation and dehydration.¹¹ Minimise tissue breakdown from external factors with skin barrier products.¹¹ 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use a pH balanced cleanser to promote healthy skin.¹⁶ Use a moisturiser to maintain moisture balance and reduce the risk of skin damage.¹⁶ Protect the skin from moisture sources (e.g. incontinence) to reduce the risk of skin damage.¹⁶ 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Cleanse with a no-rinse, pH-balanced cleanser and avoid the use of alkaline soaps.¹² Keep the skin clean and dry and inspect regularly.¹³ Before applying skin care, rule out infection. Skin care may include skin barriers to protect the skin from moisture and irritation.¹³

Skin tears, IAD and pressure injuries present significant challenges for people, including causing pain, discomfort, and reduced mobility. Prevention and management strategies are crucial for improving patient outcomes and reducing healthcare costs.

Clinical evidence suggests a structured skin care regimen with products to cleanse, protect and care for skin, can significantly decrease the incidence of skin tears⁷ and prevent the onset of IAD and PIs.⁸

A preventative skin care strategy includes selecting the right cleanse, protect and care products to suit the assessed needs of the skin. Skin at lower risk of irritation requires products that can support and maintain the acid protection mantle. Skin at a higher risk of irritation requires skin care formulations designed to penetrate the deeper layers of the skin for maximum nourishment and protection.
